End Perverse Subsidies

- Even with a subsidy a solar water heater can still cost over R15 000.
- But the wealthy are given R6 000 to save on electricity bills.
- While the poorer majority must pay higher electricity bills.
- For two solar water heaters of the same efficiency, the cheaper one must receive a higher percentage rebate.
- **R500 Challenge**
- ECOPEACE Party has helped build a R500 solar water heater that can heat 100 litres of water over 65 degrees



Create Jobs

- Eskom could mass produce solar water heaters at lower cost and improved designs
- Nearly every household could have a solar heater
- Cut electricity consumption by 10%
- no more Load Shedding
- no World Bank Debt
- no new Coal Fired Power Stations
(with high water consumption and acid water pollution)
