National Assembly Question: 114

114. Ms B D Ferguson (Cope) to ask the Minister of Energy:

Whether he has found that the draft update of the Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) adequately caters for the introduction of the private power generation; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details regarding the level of power generation that would meet the demand that could return over the medium term should supply-side confidence be restored? NW119E

Reply

No. The Integrated Resource Plan does not seek to pronounce on who the developer of the proposed build programme will be (i.e. private or public). It merely outlines South Africa's policy aspirations relating to power generation technology mix for the next 20 years. The final IRP will have both medium term and long term power projects without prescribing who the developer should be.
