## COVID-19: DISASTER MANAGEMENT AMENDMENT REGULATIONS

- Government has gazetted, for public comment, the draft post national state of disaster regulations pertaining to the management of COVID-19 in terms of 27(2) of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 (Act No. 57 of 2002).
- The draft regulations have been published for public comment for a period of 48 hours ending on Friday, 1 April 2022.
- The limited comment period is to ensure that government can end the state of disaster as soon as possible, while responsibly putting in place regulations relating to post-disaster recovery and rehabilitation.
- Following an assessment of public comments, the President will announce the withdrawal of the National State of Disaster.
- It is imperative that the withdrawal is managed responsibly to avert a compromise of existing pandemic management tools.
- We invite all citizens to make written representations regarding the draft post national state of disaster regulations.
