## COVID-19: TRANSITIONAL MEASURES

- South Africa is no longer in a state of disaster.
- A few transitional measures remain and will automatically lapse after 30 days.
- We are still required to wear a face mask in an indoor public space.
- The existing restrictions on gatherings will continue- indoor and outdoor venues can take up to 50% of their capacity without any maximum limit, provided that proof of vaccination or a COVID test not older than 72 hours is required for entrance to the venue.
- Travellers entering South Africa will need to show proof of vaccination or a negative PCR test not older than 72 hours.
- The directions that provide for the payment of the special R350 Social Relief of Distress Grant remain in place.
- Directions that provide for the extension of the validity of a learner's licence, driving licence card, licence disc, professional driving permit and registration of a motor vehicle remain in place.
- Vaccination remains our best defence against COVID-19. Let us make sure that we are vaccinated and encourage others to get vaccinated.
