HEALTH REGULATIONS

- The Minister of Health Dr Joe Phaahla has extended the period for public comments on health regulations to 5 July 2022.
- The health regulations are related to the Surveillance and Control of Notifiable Medical Conditions, Public Measures in Points of Entry, Management of Human Remains and Environmental Health.
- Comments must be sent only to this e-mail: legalreviews@health.gov.za on or before the expiry of three (3) months period from the date of publication.
- Furthermore, the department of health has gazetted the limited regulations to contain the spread of COVID-19 and future notifiable medical conditions, which is effective 5 May 2022.
- These regulations mainly focus on wearing of face masks, gatherings and persons entering the country.
- Members of the public are reminded that COVID-19 remains a life-threatening disease; vaccination and adhering to preventative measures at all times remains crucial in our fight against the pandemic.
