# Post registration changes to PoAs and CPAs

---

- **Temporary deviations** from the registered monitoring plan and/or monitoring methodology
- **Permanent changes**
  1. **Corrections;**
  2. **Changes to start date of crediting period;**
  3. **Permanent changes to the registered monitoring plan** including changes for application of latest sampling standard;
  4. **Changes to programme design in registered PoA ;**
  5. **Changes to project design in generic or specific CPA.**



## Changes to programme design in registered PoA

---

Changes to programme design in registered PoA limited to;

- a) Changes to programme boundary to expand geographical coverage or to include additional host Parties;
- b) Updates to the eligibility criteria under the circumstances indicated in the PoA standard (e.g. to implement changes decided by the Board if an issue related to environment integrity is identified);
- c) If a PoA includes more than one generic CPA-DD, addition of specific case CPA-DDs corresponding to generic CPA-DDs for which a specific case CPA-DD has not been submitted at the time of request for registration of the PoA;
- d) Removal of methodologies from the registered PoA.



## Changes to project design in generic or specific CPA

---

The following conditions have to be met to modify or add technologies/measures:

1. The applicability conditions of methodologies and tools applied cover the modified or added technologies/measures (i.e. the modified or added technologies/measure are applicable under the approved baseline and monitoring methodologies);
2. The modified or added technologies/measures were already included in the originally registered PoA-DD and the eligibility criteria for these technologies/measures had been specified in the originally registered PoA-DD.
  - Modifications to technologies/measures may include changes to effective output capacity



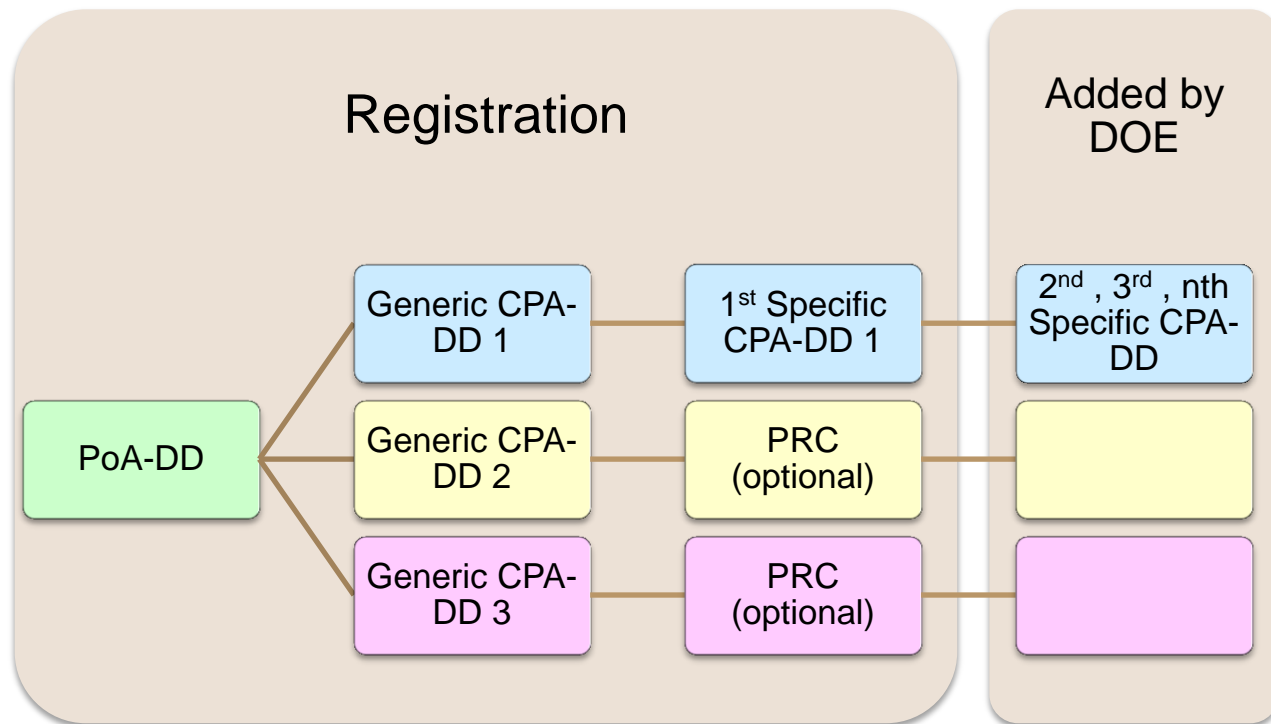
## Changes to project design in generic or specific CPA

---

- Example: PoA-DD indicated charging LED lamps from the grid or renewable energy mini grids/power packs and/or from mechanical energy
- CPA DDs indicated LED lamps charged by mechanical energy only (e.g. Nuru cycle)
- Charging from other renewable energy sources such as solar PV electricity or grid is also necessary during implementation
