MINISTER GWEDE MANTASHE TO PARTICIPATE AT THE AFRICAN ENERGY WEEK IN CAPE TOWN

The Minister of Mineral Resources and Energy, Mr. Gwede Mantashe, MP, will open the African Energy Week on 09 November 2021 in Cape Town, South Africa.

The Minister will also have bilateral meetings with various of his counterparts from the continent to discuss, among others, mutual trade and investment relations in the energy space. It is the firm view of the Ministry that, increased cooperation among African countries is key to economic growth and development in the continent. Also, economic integration among African countries will ensure benefits accrue at a continental level. Further, cooperation at this level is good for the energy needs of the individual countries and Africa as a whole.
