The Department of Mineral Resources and Energy's (DMRE) National Liaison Office (NLO) would be hosting the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Director, Division for Africa Technical Cooperation, Professor Shaukat Abdulrazak on an official visit to South Africa to engage with stakeholders in the Technical Cooperation Programme.
