

Government to regulate gas

Energy Minister Dipuo Peters invited players in the energy industry on Monday to invest in Liquid Petroleum Gas (LPG). "Opportunity exists to make a significant impact as South Africa, Africa, and the world diversify their energy mix," she told an annual LPGas safety association conference in Fourways, Johannesburg. The conference was organised by the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Safety Association of Southern Africa. The purpose of the conference was to create a greater awareness of the benefits of using LPGas as the suitable alternative energy. The theme of the conference was `safe energy for 2010`. "LP Gas, I am told, is more efficient than most energy carriers when it is used for space heating and cooking", said the Minister.
